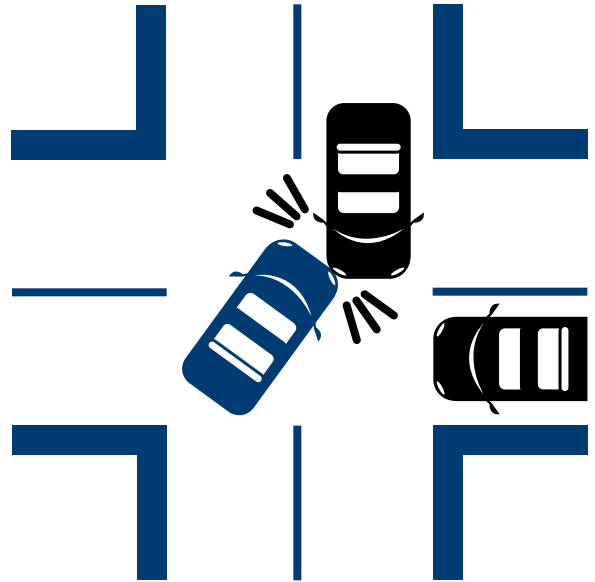




# SAFETY BRIEF

## 10 TIPS FOR INTERSECTION SAFETY

1. **Be prepared to yield** – Don't assume that just because you have the right of way that others will yield to you.
2. **Make a full stop** – Make sure to stop at stop signs to evaluate who has the right of way.
3. **Watch for other vehicles** – Keep a lookout for any cars that may be running a yellow or red light at the intersection.
4. **Be aware of pedestrians** – Watch for pedestrians or bicyclists that may be crossing the road.
5. **Look for oncoming traffic** – Reduce your risk of an accident by being aware of your surroundings and other drivers on the road.
6. **Be cautious** – Even if you have the right of way, be cautious when going through intersections.
7. **Avoid following too closely** – Keep a safe driving distance between you and the vehicle in front of you.
8. **Use your turn signals** – Alert other drivers on the road about your intent by signaling.
9. **Slow down** – Reduce your speed when approaching lights that have been green for a longer period of time. Chances are they will be turning yellow soon.
10. **Stop behind the marked line or crosswalk** – Leave an adequate amount of space for pedestrians to cross.
