PUTTING ON YOUR RESPIRATOR

You may be required to wear a respirator if you work with certain hazardous materials or in hazardous situations. Follow these steps to safely put on different types of respirators:

FILTERING FACE MASK

- Inspect the device for any damages
- Place the device on your face with the nose piece covering your nose
- Pull the top strap over your head and position it high on the back of your head
- Pull the bottom strap over your head and position it below your ears
- Mold the nose strip to your nose and check for leaks

CARTRIDGE FACE MASK

- Inspect for any loose, missing or damaged parts
- Make sure you are using the correct type of cartridge for the exposure
- Pull the bottom strap over your head—the strap should lay flat on the back of your neck
- Place the face piece under your chin and over your nose
- Pull the top strap over the crown of your head
- Check for leaks

SUPPLIED AIR RESPIRATOR

- Inspect equipment and ensure carry-on bottle is fully charged
- Place shoulder strap over left shoulder with escape bottle resting on right hip
- Fasten waist strap buckle and adjust the manifold and escape bottle as necessary
- Rest the airline from the manifold and escape bottle across the back
- Place face seal over the head and adjust the straps as necessary
- Connect the carry-on bottle to the manifold
- Open the carry-on bottle valve to ensure air is flowing
- Connect regulator to the face piece
